- Populace Choice of Best Heraldic Costume
- Best Use of Heraldry on a Garment or Ensemble (using colors, device/arm, or badge)
- **Best Livery** (e.g., on retainers or retinue, one members of a branch, on members of an Order, or members of a household that has an approved device) This would be a group award, and will only be awarded if a group of people arrives at the Ball together. Please let our judges know you wish to be judged in a group.
- **Best Marshaled Garment** (those who have one device on one side and another on the other side of their garment each half on the front of the garment) This can be a couple's award, or if there is one person who has the best garment the award will go to them.
- **Best Canting on a Costume** (This is your chance to make a play on words with your heraldry
