

An Tír Conflict Zones

Updated April 2013



Avacal, Summits, Tir Righ and Central An Tir all have similar, but separately managed conflict zone procedures. Central An Tir is governed only by kingdom where as the principalities (Avacal, Summits and Tir Righ) each have their own internal conflict zones procedures in place. Each described here in their own section.

Central An Tir Areas

Events can be either Level 1 or Level 2. Level 1 events allow no conflict, though the event steward may put on the EIF form specific branches they will allow to conflict with them. Level 2 events allow conflicts with any other branch.

Inlands Region (Northern ID, Northeastern OR & Eastern WA)

The Inlands Region goes by travel time and distance between Branches. Each Branch has its conflicts listed with its name.

Tir Righ

Tir Righ follows Kingdom policy with respect to conflict zones. The only exception is what is outlined in Principality Law which is as follows:

Section 1 – Schedule

Tir Righ Coronet Tournaments shall take place after An Tir Crown Tournaments.

1. The Coronet Events are:
 - a. June Coronet Tourney: three weeks after the Victoria Day long weekend (An Tir May Crown).
 - b. August Investiture: one week before Labour Day long weekend (but must not conflict with Pennsic).
 - c. November Coronet Tourney: first weekend in November, prior to Crown Council and Avacal November Coronet.
 - d. February Investiture: third weekend of February (but must not conflict with Estrella).
2. The Principality Events are:

- a. Avacal Tir Righ War: the last weekend in June or as agreed between the Principalities of Avacal and Tir Righ.
- b. Tir Righ Arts, Sciences and Bardic Championships: the fourth weekend in September.

Section 2 – Conflicting Events

Within the borders of Tir Righ, no event may conflict with a Coronet or Principality Event without the express permission of the Coronet.

Section 3 – Event Bids

1. Bid from branches under probation or suspension will not be considered.
2. Coronet or Principality Events shall be open to bid by any branch within Tir Righ; Bids may be accepted up to two years in advance.
3. The Principality Financial Committee will select the winning bid. If there are no suitable bids the Coronet and Principality Seneschal will work with the branches to ensure that the event is carried out as scheduled.

Summits

Summits conflict zones are only within Summits.

Level 1

Restricted event, no one within the borders of the Summits can have an event during that time. If you wish to, you can choose other groups that may conflict.

Level 2

Open events allow other groups to conflict as long as they are also level 2.
UNLESS this is the groups reserved weekend.

So, basically, if it is the Barony/Shire/canton reserved weekend, and they plan to have court with Crown or Coronet present, they will choose Level 1.
Most groups choose Level 1 for the events so there is no conflict.
